USE OF THE DANGER PLACARD

- 1) The large means of containment (LMoC) contains two (2) or more dangerous goods that require different placards
- 2) The dangerous goods loaded into the large means of containment are contained in two (2) or more small means of containment (SMoC)

The "DANGER" placard must NOT be used in the following shipments:

⇒ E R A P	⇒ Class 4.3 <i>Water-reactive Substances</i>
⇒ Class 1 <i>Explosives</i>	⇒ Class 5.2 (emergency/control temp) <i>Organic Peroxides, Type B, (liquid / solid)</i>
⇒ Class 2.1 (by ship) <i>Flammable Gases</i>	⇒ Class 6.1 (special provision 23) <i>Toxic Substances</i>
⇒ Class 2.3 <i>Toxic Gases</i>	⇒ Class 7 – Category III <i>Radioactive Materials</i>
